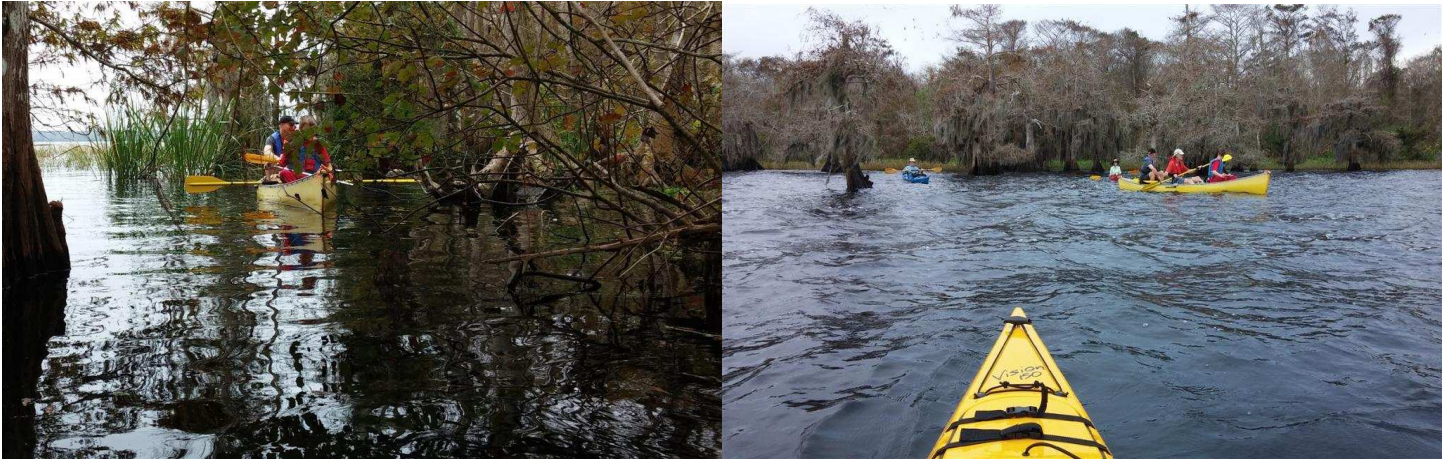




The Great

Blue Cypress Canoe Run

Trip started at the fish camp on the west side of Blue Cypress Lake, proceeded north along the west shore and cut across the lake northward in the C-40 canal to its end. (Blue Cypress Lake is located between Vero Beach and Yeehaw Junction). Had to portage over two airboat jumps into the west end of the Stick Marsh. From paddled eastward to the Fellsmere boat ramp and the end of the C-54 canal. Although a good portion of the run was in a 50-60 ft canal, the scenery was not only impressive but also eerie in the Stick Marsh. It took 5.5 hrs to cover the 11.2 miles.
